TIMELINE

LAST THREE MONTHS Confirm all vendor details | Plan your honeymoon | Obtain any necessary marriage licenses | Relax and enjoy the anticipation!

PLANNING TIPS

- **"Guest Request" Line on RSVPs:** Encourage guests to suggest a song they'd love to hear the DJ play.
- **Create a "Wishing Well":** Instead of a traditional guest book, guests leave well wishes, funny anecdotes, or even small donations to a charity of your choice.
- **Offer a Signature Cocktail:** Name it after yourselves or something unique to your relationship.
- **Incorporate Local Flavors:** Serve mini lobster rolls, clam chowder shooters, or maple syrup-infused desserts.
- **Embrace the Season:** Consider having a fall wedding with vibrant foliage or a winter wedding with a cozy atmosphere.
- **Incorporate Local Elements:** Use New England-inspired decor, such as mason jars, burlap, and wooden accents.
- **Offer Seasonal Treats:** Serve apple cider donuts, maple syrup, or pumpkin pie at your reception.
